Dear Ms. Perez:

I have reviewed your request to the Los Angeles Police Department ("The Department") made under the California Public Records Act ("The Act") for any police and/or court records regarding incidents involving Vicente Avila Lozano re TA105024.

In accordance with the California Government Code, Section 6254(f), records of investigations conducted by, or investigatory files compiled by, any local police agency for law enforcement purposes are exempt from disclosure. To the extent that records were located, they are either investigatory records themselves or properly part of an investigative file. Therefore, I am denying your request. The records may be provided pursuant to a subpoena or court order related to pending litigation.

The release of criminal history information is governed by Penal Code Section 11105, which lists specific parties who are authorized to receive such information. It does not appear that you are an authorized party; therefore, your request is denied. Additionally, please be advised that criminal history records are maintained by the State of California Department of Justice

Also, any court documents are not Department documents and you may wish to contact the Courts regarding this matter.
